

## **ST. ANDREW'S-SEWANEE SCHOOL**

**Co-Ed Episcopal 247 students Boarding Years 8-12**

St. Andrew's-Sewanee School (SAS) is a private, co-educational, Episcopal, day and boarding, college preparatory school. Located on a beautifully wooded and historic campus high atop the Cumberland Plateau in Sewanee, Tennessee between Nashville and Chattanooga, SAS offers students in grades 6-12 (boarding from grade 8) an innovative curriculum presented by a creative and engaged faculty who are dedicated to cultivating well-rounded and thoughtful human beings. SAS was named one of the eight most beautiful high schools in the South by *Southern Living* magazine. The St. Andrew's Sewanee community cultivates creativity, celebrates individuality, and rejoices in the natural world. Founded in 1942, High Mowing School (HMS) is an accredited Waldorf co-educational high school serving day and boarding students in Wilton, New Hampshire. Less than two hours from Boston, Wilton is a small, charming New England town. High Mowing is located at the top of a hill, offering beautiful views in a rural setting, yet a thriving small-town downtown is within walking distance. High Mowing School is a place for young adults to grow intellectually, artistically, and socially while living and learning with students from across town and around the world.
